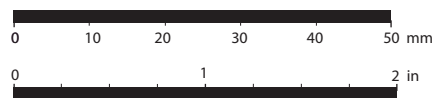


DETERMINING YOUR RING SIZE IS EASY

Please follow our simple instructions and you're just a few steps away from knowing your correct ring size.

1. Before you print this guide, be sure page scaling in your print preferences is set to "none" in the print dialog box.
2. Measure the bar shown at left to ensure it is exactly 2 inches, or 50mm long.
3. An inaccurate measurement could mean that you are not printing the page at full size.

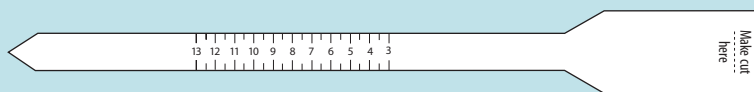
CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE



METHOD 1

OBTAIN FINGER MEASUREMENT USING BEVERLY CLARK DIAMOND'S PAPER RING SIZE TEMPLATE.

1. Using a pair of scissors, clip carefully around the outline of the Beverly Clark ring sizing template. Create a small cut in the left side of the sizing template.
2. Place the template around the finger to be measured making sure the numbers are visible on the outside.



3. Slip the narrow end of the template through the cut.
4. Move the template over the thickest portion of the finger, which is often your knuckle.
5. Draw the template firmly around the finger for an accurate measurement.
6. The correct size of the finger is indicated by the number that lines up with the cut.

Tips for obtaining an accurate measurement

- Fingers are smallest when cold—measure later in the day when hands are warm
- Relax your hand—flexing expands the muscles in your fingers
- Avoid measuring an injured finger that may be swollen

METHOD 2

USING YOUR OWN RING TO OBTAIN A MEASUREMENT

1. Use a ring that is worn on the "ring finger" (located between the "pinky" and middle finger. It is customary in the United States to wear an engagement or wedding ring on the ring finger.
2. Line up the ring images below with your ring until you find one that closely matches the inside edge of the ring. This measurement provides the diameter of the ring.
3. If your ring measures between sizes, we recommend that you use the larger size when ordering your ring from Beverly Clark Diamonds.
